

Important Changes to Air Conditioning Regulations

Due to changes in the regulations governing the repair and servicing of Mobile Air Conditioning Systems or "MACS", from July 4th 2010 it will be illegal for any person or persons, not qualified and certificated to the required standard, to either work on, service or repair air conditioning systems fitted to motor vehicles or purchase refrigerant for any purpose whatsoever.

The new DEFRA regulations stipulate that any person working on vehicle air conditioning systems must have a DEFRA approved refrigerant handler qualification. The Andrew Page Autoeducation programme now includes an ATA accredited qualification which meets regulation EC307/2008 and lasts for five years.
